Policy

The Copyright Act of 1978 (PL 94-553) provides statutory protection for all writings/photographs/images from the dates of their creation, whether or not they are formally copyrighted. Generally, the term of copyright is the life of the author plus seventy years, however, special provisions do exist, i.e., the Sonny Bono Copyright Term Extension Act. It is the responsibility of the researcher to be aware of current copyright law and to obtain permission for the publication and commercial use of material not clearly in the public domain, as penalties for violation of this statute are severe. Current copyright law is available through the U.S. Copyright Office (101 Independence Avenue, SE, Washington, DC 20559-6000; <http://www.copyright.gov/title17/92chap3.html>).

A one-time user fee may be charged, based on a sliding scale, for the commercial use of each document/image for a single, specified project only. Further use of a document/image for another project/purpose requires a new application for permission and payment of additional fees.

In requesting to publish/reproduce materials from these collections, the requester agrees to indemnify and hold the Associated Archives at St. Mary's Seminary and University and its staff harmless and free from liability for acts of the requester in any action involving infringement of the rights of any person or heirs and descendants under statutory copyright.
